WELCOME TO YOUR SHOW

2009 marks the 15th year that the Founder Lions Club of Wichita Falls, Texas has reestablished The Texas-Oklahoma Fair which began in Wichita Falls in 1922. After 5 years it failed. It then moved to Iowa Park, Texas as the Wichita County Free Fair (in the 40's). It expanded to a two state festival and again became the Texas-Oklahoma Fair in 1947. Purpose of the fair was to stimulate interest in agriculture, livestock, and industry of this region. Midways, rodeos, free entertainment, educational exhibits, contests, political speeches, and pioneers highlighted the annual show. Only in 1942 (World War II) was the fair cancelled. The horror of September 11th, 2001, on opening day of the Wichita Falls fair did not crush the 'SPIRIT' of exhibitors or visitors, as the events were dedicated to the memory of those murdered in the Attack on America! Attendance in 2002 BOUNCED BACK and; went over 117,000.

An estimated crowd of 175,000 viewed the 1961 fair, but tragedy struck in 1962 when fire hit the main auditorium prior to the fall opening. The show went on with tents, but a second fire the following January ended the Texas/Oklahoma Fair in Iowa Park, Texas.

Back in Wichita Falls the active members of Founder Lions Club started the Wichita County Fair (with and without livestock) using the downtown Activities Center (now the new library) but they saw the desire to show livestock and highlight the 4-H and FFA youth. The club started the fund to build the MPEC Agriculture Center and the new Texas-Oklahoma Fair returned to Wichita Falls in 1995 on the third week of September each year!

1. Junior and Senior shows are seperately santioned.
2. This is a two ring show for AOP, LaMancha, Nubian Saanen, Sable, Recorded Grade, Nigerian Dwarf
Entry fees are \$6 per animal per show if postmarked prior to September 6th, or e-mailed by the 8th.
Late entries will be \$7 per animal.
3. The base date for figuring ages is September 19, 2009, the show date.
4. The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older.
This certificate **MUST BE SHOWN** to the Show secretary before the start of the show.
5. The original registration certificate or duplicate application stamped by ADGA is required for all animals under six months of age and this **MUST BE SHOWN** to the Show secretary before the start of the show.
6. No copies of the registration certificates or the, telegrams, or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the original certificate.
7. Entries must comply with Texas Animal Health Commission requirements.
Certificates of veterinary inspection (made within last 30 days) must accompany all goats and be available upon request. Any animal that appears to be sick will be removed from the show grounds at the request of the show committee.
8. ALL GRAND CHAMPION animals **MUST** compete for best in show.
9. Pens are on a first come first serve basis and the area that the dairy goats will be in will be marked. We have plenty of pens, enough for tack pens as well, but please be considerate of others. \$2 pen fee will be charged.
10. Youth Showmanship classes will begin in Ring 1 at 8:00 AM. and is followed with the Youth wether show
11. Please show your finished champions in the Champion Challenge class.
