WELCOME TO YOUR SHOW

2011 marks the 17th year that the Founder Lions Club of Wichita Falls, Texas has re-established the Texas-Oklahoma fair which began in Wichita Falls in 1922 and after 5 years it failed. It then moved to Iowa Park, Texas as the Wichita County Free Fair (in the 40's). It expanded to a two state festival and again became the Texas-Oklahoma Fair in 1947. The purpose of the fair was to stimulate interest in agriculture, livestock, and the industry of this region. Midways, rodeos, free entertainment, educational exhibits, contests, political speeches, and pioneers highlighted the annual show. Only one year was it cancelled which was during World War II in 1942. In 1961, an estimated crowd of 175,000 attended the fair, but tragedy struck in 1962 when a fire hit the main auditorium prior to the fall opening. The show went on with tents, but a second fire the following January ended the Texas-Oklahoma Fair in Iowa Park, Texas.

The active members of the Wichita Falls Founder Lions Club saw the desire to show livestock and highlight the 4-H and FFA youth and once again brought life back to the Wichita County Fair (with and without livestock) using the downtown Activities Center (now the new library). The club started the fund to build the MPEC Agriculture Center and the Texas-Oklahoma Fair returned to Wichita Falls in 1995 on the third week of September of each year, increasing attendance every year! Not even the terrorist attacks or the horror of September 11th, 2001 taking place on opening day did not crush the 'SPIRIT' of our exhibitors or visitors. The events were dedicated to the memory of those murdered in the attack on America! The following year in 2002 the attendance grew to over 117,000 in attendance. Good luck to all our exhibitors and may this be the best year yet!
